Minutes: Motion made and seconded to approve September's minutes. Passed unanimously.

Treasury: Kevin Dillon presented his Treasurer's Report, which stated that the Operating Account has a balance of **\$221,132.01**. As well, the Endowment Fund has a balance of **\$80,780.14**. Kevin explained that the reason for the operating account being so large was that the Philip Morse donation of **\$200,000** was wired into the DEEP account just yesterday and the balance will now be invested via *Cornerstone Financial*. Motion to accept the Treasurer's Report was made, seconded, and passed unanimously.

Public Relations: Gayla Bartlett was unable to make this morning's meeting so President Mary Beth Verry reported that a press release has gone out to all local papers concerning the upcoming Wine Tasting, and that the Salem News and Danvers Herald have promised to have reporters present at the event. Kevin Dillon, Treasurer, has reached out to the North Shore Chamber for their support of the Wine Tasting as well, and Mary Beth Verry has arranged for the Wine Tasting banner to be hung at the Maple Street site beginning this coming Friday, October 15th.

Wine Tasting: 80's THEME! The Wine Tasting Committee reported that just some of the local restaurants that have elected to participate this year include: British Beer Company, Texas Road House, Buffalo Wild Wings, Kelly's Roast Beef, Olive Garden, Burtons Grille, and the Danversport Yacht Club.
