Members Present: Mark Strout, Kevin Dillon, Michele Keith, Mari Matt, Mary Wermers, Richard Stoney, Sean Emberley, Dr. Lisa Dana, Jessie DelVecchio and Angela Tsiumis.

Minutes: September minutes were approved by Mark Strout, seconded and passed unanimously.

Treasurer's Report: Michele provided her report and advised that everything is holding steady. She met with Cornerstone Financial to transfer \$15,000.00 from the DEEP Investment into the Operating Account to cover the \$2,500.00 in grant money awarded to each school. A check for grants in the amount of \$17,500.00, which will provide \$2,500 to each of the Danvers Public Schools, was dropped off to Dr. Dana. There is currently \$15,484.62 in the Operating Account and \$297,252.61 in the Investment Account. A motion was made by Mark Strout, seconded and passed unanimously to approve the Treasurer's Report.

Public Relations: Mari Matt appeared on DCAT's *Community Connection* to talk about DEEP and how we provide grants to the teachers in the Danvers Public Schools. She also spoke about this year's Virtual Downtown Tree Lighting program.

Virtual Downtown Tree Lighting: This year DEEP, along with DanversCARES, DCAT and East Boston Savings Bank, will be sponsoring a Virtual Downtown Tree Lighting. The air date for the Tree Lighting program will be Saturday, December 12. The program will be hosted by Ben Thomas from DCAT. There will be musical segments, stories, Santa will arrive by fire truck to light the tree, and other surprises. DEEP will also be offering residents the opportunity to purchase a personalized ornament, decorated by DHS students, to be hung on this year's tree. Mark Strout motioned to spend \$1,000.00 to cover the cost of ornaments and decorating supplies. The motion was seconded and passed unanimously.

New Business: Mark Strout advised that Essex Tech will be holding a Virtual Gala this year. It will include a 3-course meal that can be picked up at the school. The gala will include a virtual auction and Joan Lovely will be a keynote speaker. Tickets are \$25.00 and can be purchased on the Essex Tech website.

Jessie DelVecchio is the Assistant Center Director for Mathnasium in North Beverly, and is looking to start virtual math nights in January. She would love to have the Danvers Public Schools included in the program, which will be done all online. Jessie will send out more information to Mary Beth and Mari regarding the program.
