Minutes: Motion was made to accept the June meeting minutes and passed unanimously.

Treasury: Diane Langlais presented the committee with a comprehensive report of the organizations accounts. She also stated that she is going to utilize Quickbooks to keep track of all the different fundraising efforts that DEEP sponsors. Diane and Glenn Boutchie will be the only signatores on the checking account. Total assets of the corporation stand at \$130,549.13.

Hall of Honor: Dr. Lisa Dana spoke about the Hall of Honor, and after a robust conversation, the committee's recommendation was that it should be on an every-other-year basis. We look forward to having people recommend candidates for the following categories: DHS Graduate, Retired Teacher, and Friend of the Danvers Public Schools, all to be honored in March of 2014. **Stay tuned!**

Wine Tasting: The annual DEEP Wine Tasting is the major fundraiser of the year. We are asking that you reserve the date of October 24th from 6:00-9:00 PM at the Danversport Yacht Club. We have vintners from all over the world, restaurants from all over the North Shore, gift baskets to be raffled off, and a live auction. We are further asking that EVERYONE (teachers, administrators, staff) consider helping out at the event. Vice President Glenn Boutchie is the Chair of the Wine tasting and needs your HELP! Technology Campaign: Jeff Liberman, Director of Technology, stated that DEEP has raised over *\$325,000* for the DHS Technology Campaign. Five (5) labs have been funded thus far. We still need to raise another \$150,000. Labs yet to be named are the CAD, T.V., Music Tech, and Digital Photography Labs. If anyone wants to make a smaller financial contribution of let's say \$5,000 to \$10,000, DEEP will gladly put a contributor's plaque on the wall of the individual labs; however, **FULL naming rights will cost \$50,000!** All of the labs will have their donor plaques unveiled at the October dedication of Danvers High School

DECA School Store: DEEP has voted to loan the DECA organization at Danvers High School \$4000 as seed money to get the new DHS store "FalconsNest" up and running. Treasurer Diane Langlais made the suggestion that the DECA students write a "business plan" to determine what exactly they will be selling and how they intend to pay back DEEP the seed money. The entire committee applauded the past efforts of the DECA (Distributive Education) class at DHS and their *national ranking* in competitions around the country.

Rail Trail: Voted to table a request that DEEP contribute to the Rail Trail Mural Committee until a future date. It was felt by the committee that DEEP's efforts to raise funds for the Technology Campaign, the Thorpe

Library Campaign, and the Teacher Grant Program are all that can be handled successfully at this time.

DHS Band: Voted to table a request by the DHS Band for an \$1100 donation to defray the cost of transporting students to Disney World during the winter vacation. It was felt by the committee that DEEP's efforts to raise funds for the Technology Campaign, the Thorpe Library Campaign, and the Teacher Grant Program are all that can be handled successfully at this time.

Thorpe Library Fundraiser: Principal Rita Ward announced that she has sold over 100 books at this time. "Spring Is Different This Year" is a wonderful children's book about an event that happens annually within the courtyard at Thorpe School. Rita plans on having a "grand opening" of sorts for the sale of the book and we encourage everyone to purchase a copy. Thorpe hopes to begin construction of their library next year. Please help to raise \$50,000 by purchasing a copy.

Membership Drive: Secretary Mark Strout stated that he has been working diligently to convince people to become members of DEEP throughout the summer. So far, we have **59 Teacher memberships**, **37 Family memberships**, **and 12 Corporate memberships for the coming year.** As well, we have sold \$1,850 in DHS auditorium chairs thus far this summer, we have collected \$400 in technology donations, and we continue to encourage teachers, families, and business owners to join DEEP and support the Danvers Public Schools.

Presidential Goals for 2014: Our new President, Gayla Bartlett, articulated her goals for the coming year. Gayla is extremely well known and respected amongst North Shore business groups. Gayla would like to see our executive committee grow to include at least one parent from each elementary school. She would like to see our corporate membership grow by 10. To increase our community exposure to gain more members and sell more auditorium seats she has arranged: a table at Endicott park Day and Oldies Night, sponsoring a Musical Instrument Drive at DHS, we will have a table at Santa by the Sea, we are co-sponsoring the Danvers Historical Society's "History Essay" contest during Family Festival this coming summer, will be hosting a new DCAC/TV show entitled "Danvers Education Watch" with Dr. Dana as the first guest and being co-produced

by Mary Beth Verry, Gayla wants to groom the next generation of leaders, also to increase our standing committee participation, and to have Matt Schroeder stay on as past-president to oversee the DEEP Technology Campaign.
