**Minutes:** Motion was made to accept the September meeting minutes and passed unanimously.

**Treasury:** Diane Langlais presented the committee with a comprehensive report of the organizations accounts. A motion to accept was unanimously approved. Total assets of the corporation stand at \$124,900.64.

This, along with another \$12,000 already earmarked for the Technology Campaign, will pay the Apple invoice. Matt also announced that his Technology Committee is pursuing a grant from the Lahey Clinic and the Cummings Center in Beverly. PLEASE continue to ask family members if they have any connections to major corporations, especially here on the North Shore, that we might be able to pursue additional grants from.

**DECA School Store:** It was announced that the DHS school store "Falcon's Nest" is up and running. THANK YOU to the DEEP Executive Committee for approving a \$4,000 loan to stock the store with inventory.
