*Treasury:* Kevin Dillon presented his comprehensive Treasurer's Report, which stated that the Operating Account has a balance of \$18,856.84. As well, the Endowment Fund has a balance of \$110,289.86. Motion to accept the Treasurer's Report was made, seconded, and passed unanimously.

*Investment Committee:* President Mary Beth Verry led a discussion concerning the meeting held in August with Cornerstone Financial Partners LLC. Mary Beth reported that both Carlie Dugan, CFP, and Greg Miner, CFP, made a thorough presentation to the officers regarding investment alternatives for both the Endowment Fund and the \$200,000 donation which is to be made by Mr. Philip Morse.

**Public Relations:** Gayla Bartlett reported that a press release has gone out to all local papers concerning the upcoming Wine Tasting. Gayla stated that she has requested that Karen Andreas, Salem News Publisher, conduct an interview with the Wine Tasting Committee as to their accomplishments thus far. As well, Gayla stated that Kevin Dillon, Treasurer, has reached out to the North Shore Chamber for their support of the Wine Tasting, as well.
