Members Present: Mary Beth Verry, Donna Hopkins, Glenn Boutchie, Dr. Lisa Dana, Angela Tsiumis, Mari Matt, Jeff Liberman, Mary Wermers, Jill Michaud, and Mark Strout.

Minutes: Motion made and seconded to approve October's minutes. Passed unanimously.

Treasury: Kevin Dillon prepared his Treasurer's Report, which President Mary Beth Verry read. Mary Beth stated that the Operating Account has a balance of \$204,014.74. As well, the Endowment Fund has a balance of \$81,044.51, and that \$20,000 will be added ASAP to bring the balance above the \$100,000 figure. *Total assets of the corporation are* \$334,708.92. Motion to accept the Treasurer's Report was made, seconded, and passed unanimously.

Public Relations: Gayla Bartlett was unable to make this morning's meeting, so President Mary Beth Verry reported that **Mari Matt** would represent DEEP on DCAT's "Community Connection" show this coming Thursday evening.

Wine Tasting Report: The Wine Tasting Committee reported that a net grand total of \$16,653.76 resulted from this year's wine tasting. The committee is already "back at work" planning next year's event, which has tentatively been set for *October 19*, 2017.

The entire wine tasting committee was thanked by all in attendance for their hard work and dedication.

Cumberland Farms Grand Opening: DEEP is proud to be the recipient of the Cumberland Farms Grand Opening fundraiser – located at 76 Newbury Street, Rt. 1, Danvers, MA. For the entire month of November thru December 13th, DEEP will receive \$.10 for EVERY cup of soda/coffee sold at the store. DEEP has been guaranteed a minimum of \$1,000 and possibly up to \$4,000. We encourage ALL DEEP members, families, and friends to stop by the new location and join in the fundraising effort. Remember that EVERY penny made by DEEP goes directly to the students and teachers of the Danvers Public Schools.

Holten-Richmond "Hawks Nest" Loan: The DEEP board of directors was contacted by the HRMS school store teacher/advisor who requested a loan of \$1,000 be secured from DEEP to replenish inventory at the new "Hawks Nest" school store. This effort is in collaboration with the DECA business students at DHS. A team of DECA students will act in an advisory capacity to the middle school students who have formed a "business club". You'll remember that three (3) years ago, DEEP granted DECA a \$4,000 loan to purchase inventory for the DHS "Falcons Nest". All proceeds were paid back in full within one (1) year. The HRMS "Hawks Nest" loan is to be repaid at a rate of \$25 per month throughout the school year, until paid in full. We wish the HRMS "Hawks Nest" students the very best of luck in their endeavor.

DEEP Spelling Bee: DEEP will once again sponsor the HRMS Spelling Bee to be held at the DHS auditorium on the evening of February 9th beginning at 6:00 PM. DEEP will provide a light dinner (pizza) for the HRMS students beginning at 5:15 PM in the DHS atrium lobby. We have scheduled the Spelling Bee for February 9th to coincide with the "qualifying" dates for the national spelling bee to be held once again in Washington, D.C.

The "snow" date will be February 16th.

Thanksgiving Stadium Dedication: President Mary Beth Verry will represent DEEP in the celebratory event being planned for half time during the Danvers-Gloucester football game next week. A grand total of \$2 million has been donated by Mr. Philip Morse. \$1.6 million to defray the cost of the stadium, \$200,000 to DEEP, and \$200,000 to the Friends of the Danvers Recreation and Parks Department. The game begins at 10:00 AM. The cost of the game is \$10, and tickets may be purchased on both Monday and Tuesday from 10:00 AM to 3:00 PM at the DHS Athletic Office. Purchase your ticket early so that you can witness this historic event first hand.
