Treasury: Total assets of the corporation are **\$338,434.14**. Motion to accept the Treasurer's Report was made, seconded, and passed unanimously. Kevin Dillon went over the proposed budget with further discussion to follow in the months ahead.

DEEP Teacher Grants: The executive board was informed that **73** teachers collaborated on **26** grant applications, requesting a total of **\$29,945.02**. Chairperson of the Grant Committee, Glenn Boutchie, stated that a meeting would be set up in the future to review the grant applications for further action.
