Members Present: Mary Beth Verry, Kevin Dillon, Donna Hopkins, Glenn Boutchie, Jill Michaud, Angela Tsiumis, Mari Matt, Rich Stoney, Alex Grover, Riley Doyle, Sarah Roach, and Mark Strout.

Minutes: Motion made and seconded to approve March minutes. Passed unanimously.

Treasury: Total assets of the corporation are \$340,703.10. Motion to accept the Treasurer's Report was made, seconded, and passed unanimously. Kevin Dillon went over the proposed budget with further discussion to follow in the months ahead.

DEEP Teacher Grants: Glenn Boutchie stated that Jeff Liberman, Technology Director, and Mary Wermers, K-12 Curriculum Director, gave a presentation to the Grant Committee regarding technology needs and grant applications. 73 teachers collaborated on 26 grant applications, requesting a total of \$29,945.02. Chairperson of the Grant Committee, Glenn Boutchie, stated that a meeting would be set up in May to review the grant applications for further action. A motion was made by Mark Strout to increase this year's grant appropriations to \$20,000 based on the high need of the applicants. The motion was seconded and passed unanimously.

All recipients of the grants will be required to attend the *June 12th* school committee meeting for the awarding of checks.

"Keys to Success" Program: JILL MICHAUD of Michaud Mitsubishi and Michaud Quality Pre-Owned Vehicles will meet with Mark Strout to plan the "Key Off" on May 26th, Friday afternoon, at 1:00PM, at the front of the building with the entire school present. This program has proven to be of the most popular and motivating programs in existence at the school.

DHS DECA: Two of the DHS DECA students, *Riley Doyle and Sarah Roach*, gave a wonderful presentation to the DEEP executive board concerning the group's accomplishments thus far at the district and state levels, and their plans for competing in Anaheim, CA next month. *Motion made*, seconded and passed unanimously to award \$4,603.75 to assist them in their efforts to retain the international DECA title in California.

DEEP Breakfast of Champions: The annual DEEP Breakfast of Champions is set for June 14th at 8:00 AM in Room C-213 of Danvers High School. Not only will DEEP honor those individuals, businesses, and civic groups that have gone "above and beyond", this year's retirees will also be honored with a certificate and a coveted DEEP golf shirt.
