Minutes: A motion was made by Mark Strout and seconded to approve the October minutes, all in favor and passed unanimously.

Treasurer's Report: Michele Keith reported that the Operating Account has a balance of \$39,816.00. The Investment Account has a balance of \$311,052.03. The Market has been good which has made some interest on the Investment Account. The People's United Bank account has been closed and DEEP is using First Ipswich Bank for all of their banking. A motion to accept the Treasurer's Report was made, seconded, and passed unanimously.

Public Relations: Mary Beth Verry advised that Myrna Fearer wrote a great article that was featured in the *Danvers Herald* on the Wine Tasting. Thank you, Myrna!

On November 9th, Mary Beth Verry and Mari Matt were on *Community Connections*, a nonprofit show run by DCAT. They spoke about DEEP to advise the community on what DEEP does and what DEEP'S mission is.

Wine Tasting: Mary Beth Verry advised that this year's Wine Tasting made \$14,000.00, which is down a little from last year, and is still waiting on a sponsorship, which will bring the number up a bit. She also thanked everyone who helped the day of the event, without volunteers it would not be successful. Mari Matt spoke on behalf of the Wine Tasting Committee and advised that the event was a great success and that a great time was had by all. Next year the Wine Tasting will be going on its 20th year. That being said, the Committee is already working on a date and theme for next year.

DEEP Spelling Bee: This is the next event that DEEP sponsors. It is for students who qualify from the Holten-Richmond Middle School, and will be held in the Danvers High School auditorium on Thursday, February 8th beginning at 6:00 PM with a snow date of February 15th. Kevin Dillon advised that DECA will have a school store at the Holiday Festival Tree Lighting that is going to be held in Downtown Danvers on Saturday, December 2nd from 2:00 - 5:00.

Adam Federico, principal of HRMS, advised that there are currently 21 students involved in working in their School Store. The store is open Tuesdays during 1st and 2nd lunch, and every Tuesday and Thursday after school. They also participate in morning announcements and have a spot on Hawk's News. The students are working hard on their customer service skills, collaboration, creative marketing and financial literacy.
